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CURRICULAR COMMITTEE REPORT

The Curricular Committee has received the following petitions:

A. Modified Course:

1. Life Science 442 Histology, 3 semester hours. Old title: Histology and Histotechnique 441, 4 semester hours. New description: Lectures and laboratory studies dealing with microscopic structures of principal animal tissues.

B. New Courses:

1. Psychology 395, Industrial Psychology, 3 semester hours. Description: The relationship between an individual's goals and organizational objectives. Channeling motivations and dealing with frustrations. Interpersonal relations, patterns of leadership, supervision and decisionmaking. Customer psychology and public relations.
2. Life Science 441 Histotechnique, 2 semester hours. Description: This is primarily a laboratory course designed to familiarize the students with the preparation of plant and animal tissues for studies by light microscopy and electron microscopy.

C. Modified Programs:

1. Modification of Non-teaching Major and Minor Curricula in Economics.

Old: Major (30 hours)

Required: Economics 200 - 3 hours., 201 - 3 hours, 321 - 3 hours, 400 - 3 hours, 401 - 3 hours. Directed electives in upper level courses.

New: Major (30 hours)

Required: Economics 102 - 3 hours, 103 - 3 hours, 271 - 3 hours, 302 and 303 - 3 hours. Directed electives in upper level courses.

Old: Minor (18 hours)

Required: Economics 200 - 3 hours, 201 - 3 hours, 321 - 3 hours, 400 - 3 hours, 401 - 3 hours. Directed electives in upper level courses.

New: Minor (21 hours)

Required: Economics 102 - 3 hours, 103 - 3 hours, 271 - 3 hours, 302 or 303 - 3 hours. Directed electives in upper level courses.

2. Modification of Non-Teaching Major in Life Science

1. Required: 101-4 hours.; 102-4 hrs.; 330-4 hrs.; 374-4 hrs.; 381-1 hr. In addition, the student will select electives in the Life Sciences which will fulfill minimum requirements for the major.

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2. The following changes are involved: The elimination of L.S. 350-4 hours. from the required core curriculum, the elimination of choosing required electives from the following courses: L.S. - 342-4 hrs.; L.S. 367-3 hrs.; L.S. 428 - 4 hrs.; L.S. 461 - 3 hrs. and L.S. 480 - 3 hrs. Instead, the electives will be chosen which will best benefit the students individual program. There is an increase in the number of hours required for a major from 40 hours to 45 hours.

3. Modification of Non-Teaching Minor in Life Science

1. Required courses: Life Science 101-4 hrs.; and selected electives from the following courses: 208-4 hrs.; 221-3 hrs.; 331-3 hrs.; 367-3 hrs.; 450-4 hrs. or 350-3 hrs.; 453-3 hrs. and any other electives, except L.S. 100 and 231, to complete 25 hr. minor.

2. Reduction in the number of required courses and dropping of courses which require prerequisites from other science areas.

D. Course Eliminations

1. Life Science 201 Pharmacology 2 semester hours. Reason: No longer taught in Life Science Department.

2. Life Science 310 The Teaching of Life Sciences in the Secondary Schools 2 semester hours. Reason: Not taught in Life Science Department. Duplicates course in Division of Education.
