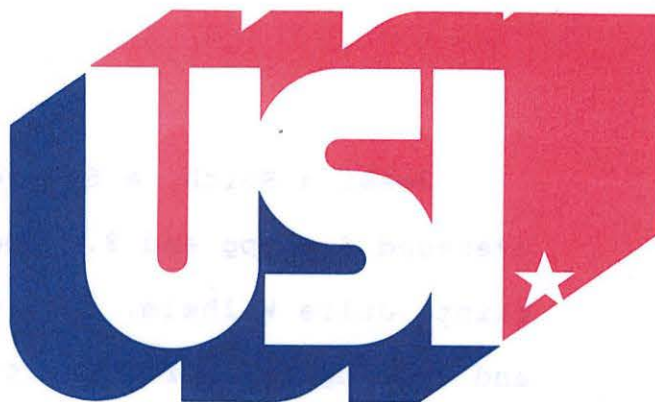

The University of Southern Indiana women's basketball program has added the name of six recruits to the roster for the 1989-90 season. Head Coach Felicia Cavallini is pleased with her first recruiting class, which includes players from all over Indiana.

Evansville Memorial product Angie Behme is a 5-9 forward who averaged 16.0 points per game (ppg). Behme led the team in rebounding with an average of 8.0 rebounds per game (rpg). The two-year starter shot 76 percent from the line and was one of the top 10 scorers in Evansville. Behme's brother Tim is a member of the USI baseball team.

Two players from the Bedford-North Lawrence team are joining the Eagles. Missy Innman, a 5-8 guard/forward, averaged 12.0 ppg and is tabbed as an outside shooter for the Eagles. Amy Aronson, a 6-0 center, averaged 14.2 ppg and 6.0 rpg. Aronson shot 72 percent from the line. The Bedford-North Lawrence team finished 24-1 and reached the final game of the Seymour Semi-State before losing to eventual state champ Scottsburg.
