2. Summer Deadlines

July 17 - Registration - Second Summer Session.

July 18 - First day of classes.

3. Student Housing

Duffie Barton or Belinda Johnson, in the Records Office will have a list of rooms and apartments available for students desiring housing.

4. Faculty Housing

New faculty desiring a home, please contact Duffie Barton in the Records Office. She is working closely with the real estate firms and rental agencies in Evansville and may be able to help locate something.

5. Forwarding Addresses

Faculty planning to be out of town either for vacation, or on leave, please leave a forwarding address with the receptionist or with someone in your department, so mail received can be forwarded.

6. Rental Property

Those seeking housing accomodations should formally register with Frank McGray. Application forms may be picked up at Duffie Barton's desk. Applicants will not be annoyed with solitutions by sales personnel. Persons seeking apartments are not required to deposit a registration fee nor will they pay a rental referred fee.

COST INFORMATION SHEET

FEES: The student cost for fees is \$18.00 for each hour of course work. To compute the cost for a semester, determine the number of hours and multiply by \$18.00. Here are some examples:

<u>Hours</u>	<u>Fee</u>
16	\$ 288
15	\$ 270
12	\$ 216
9	\$ 162
6	\$ 108
3	\$ 54

The amount of the FEES is to be paid in full at the time of registration in September.

In addition to the regular fees, there are certain courses that have an additional nominal fee for supplies.

BOOKS: The cost for books and supplies varies from about \$35.00 to \$70.00 per semester depending upon number of courses taken and the cost of the individual books for each course. Used books are available at a lower price in most subjects. These books are usually sold first.

We have a bookstore on campus and payments for the books are made to the bookstore at the time of purchase.

BUS SERVICE: The Will Coach Lines will provide bus service to the new campus. We encourage students to use available transportation facilities whenever possible, because of cost, safety and parking.

The bus company has asked us to provide the names, addresses and phone numbers of students desiring bus service next year to the new campus, and they will contact the students and make the necessary arrangements for routing and scheduling. If you are interested in using this means of transportation, please complete the blanks below and leave it with your counselor.

PARKING: All students who wish to drive to school will be required to register the automobile. There will be a nominal car registration fee.
