The Blue Cross-Blue Shield group insurance program at Indiana State University provides that once each year during the month of November an open enrollment period is made available to all employees who have not previously been enrolled.

If you make cash payment please make check payable to Indiana State University in the amount of \$4.20 for individual coverage, or \$11.32 for family coverage, on or before Thursday, November 6, and your coverage will be effective November 10, 1969. If you choose to wait and commence payments by means of payroll deductions, the effective date will be December 10, 1969.

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
