Angie Anderson...#15

5'10"...Junior....Outside Hitter...Mt. Vernon, Ind.

Played in 45 games last season, with 42 kills and a .110 hitting percentage...played in 40 games as a freshman in 1989 with 30 kills and a hitting percentage of .155...was an All-Conference performer and given the "Big Blocker" award in 1986 at Mt. Vernon H.S...an all-around athlete who also won letters in basketball and track...in basketball, she was named Defensive Player of the Year in 1985-86 and 1986-87...majoring in communications.

Cindy Billings...#7

5'8"...Senior...Middle Hitter...Newburgh, Ind.

Last season was cut short at 39 games due to a broken arm against Bellarmine...prior to being injured, she had 69 kills and a hitting percentage of .197...had 233 kills and a hitting percentage of .198, 58 solo blocks and 55 digs in 1989...was MVP and All-Conference her senior season at Castle H.S...also lettered in track and basketball...in basketball, she was captain and All-Conference in 1987-88...named Most Athletic Female at Castle H.S. in 1988...majoring in communications.

Melanie Emge...#6

5'7"...Freshman...Outside Hitter...Evansville, Ind.

Comes to USI from Mater Dei High School where she lettered in volleyball, basketball, and track...named volleyball's Best Defensive Player at MDHS last season...was the Most Valuable Distance Runner (four years), Evansville city champion in the 3200 meters (three years) and All-Conference in track at MDHS...also received the Kiwanis Award in track the past two years...major undecided.

Sheri Kaiser...#9

5'10"...Sophomore...Middle Hitter...Corydon, Ind.

Played in all 80 games as a freshman and was second in kills with 204, solo blocks with 27 and digs with 239...a two-sport athlete at USI, she was the 1991 Best Offensive Player on the USI women's basketball team, averaging 11.4 ppg and 6.3 rpg...came to USI from North Harrison H.S. in Ramsey, Ind...while at NHHS, she won ten letters in volleyball, basketball, and tennis...in 1988 and 1989 she received the Best Hitter, Best Blocker and Serve Receive awards and was All-Mid-Southern Conference in those two years for volleyball...was the 1990 Academic Athletic award winner...majoring in business.

Shawna Kuester...#8

5'9"...Freshman...Outside Hitter...Ft. Branch, Ind.

A three-letter athlete at Gibson Southern High School in volleyball, basketball and track...was All-County (1988-90), All-Conference and MVP last season at GSHS in volleyball...also named All-County, All-Conference and MVP in basketball and track at GSHS...was a state finalist in the high jump in 1991 and holds the GSHS record for the high jump at 5'5"...named Gibson County's Female Athlete-of-the-Year in 1991...major undecided.

Kim Moolenaar...#3
5'10"...Freshman...Outside Hitter...DeMotte, Ind.

A graduate of Kankakee Valley High School, she lettered in volleyball and tennis...named All-Conference (three years), All-Area (twice), and Best Offensive Player (last season) in volleyball at KVHS...set a record for kills in a season at KVHS with 293 in 1990...majoring in radiology.

Tina Nix...#5
5'8"...Freshman...Outside Hitter...Evansville, Ind.

Comes to USI from Bosse High School where she lettered in volleyball and track...was the team captain of the 1990 volleyball team at BHS...major undecided.

Leah Parsons...#13
6'0"...Junior....Middle Hitter...Loogootee, Ind.

Played in 80 games last season and again led the team in solo blocks with 34 and blocking assists with 30...was second in hitting percentage with .199 and had 155 kills...played in 108 games as a freshman and led the team in hitting percentage with .261, solo blocks with 108, assisted blocks with 61, and also finished third with 232 kills in 1989...came to USI from Loogootee H.S., where she was named MVP and All-Conference team member in 1987 and 1988, while leading the team in blocking and hitting...also played tennis at Loogootee winning two letters...majoring in business.

Denise Rossa...#11
5'3"...Junior....Setter...DeMotte, Ind.

Saw action in all 80 games last season and was second in assists with 121 and won the Kiwanis and Golden Eagle awards for the second straight season (1989-90)...played in 43 games as a freshman, mainly as a defensive specialist...an All-Conference and All-Area performer in 1987-88 at Kankakee Valley High School. where she led the volleyball squad to a final 16 finish...holds records at KVHS for set attempts (career and season), set assists (career and season) and best serving percentage (season and career)...an all-around athlete winning letters in track and basketball...majoring in physical education.

Christy Steinsultz...#14
5'7"...Sophomore...Setter...Albion, Ill.

Transferred to USI from the University of Wisconsin-Superior where she lettered in volleyball, basketball and softball...named the 1990-91 Rookie-of-the-Year at UW-S in volleyball...attended Edwards County High School and lettered in volleyball, basketball, and softball...was named to three All-Tournament teams (Edwards County, North City-Omaha-Enfield and Casey tournaments) in 1990, while receiving the Best Setter award...majoring in education.

Michelle Weesies...#10

5'8"...Freshman...Setter...Indianapolis, Ind.

An athlete from Ben Davis High School, she lettered in volleyball and tennis...named the Most Consistent, Co-MVP, All-County, honorable mention All-Metro in volleyball last season at BDHS...was the 1990 MVP, team captain (two years), and part of the 1991 number one sectional doubles champion in tennis...voted one of the top five female athletes at BDHS...major undecided.

Lisa Yockey...#12

5'10"....Senior....Outside Hitter...Boonville, Ind.

Named the Most Improved Player last year...played in 69 games, with 152 kills, 201 digs, and a hitting percentage .180 last season...saw limited action to only 42 games in 1989 due to a broken foot, and had 84 kills... was All-Conference in 1987 when Boonville H.S. finished in the top eight in the state...also was named Most Valuable Player in tennis in 1986 for BHS...majoring in communications.

HEAD COACH DAWN VANHALL

Dawn VanHall begins her fourth season as the head coach of the USI volleyball team after a 12-11 record and fifth place finish in the Great Lakes Valley Conference with a 5-4 record last season. In her two years at USI, VanHall has a career record of 40-50 as a head coach.

A native of Evansville, VanHall graduated from Western Michigan University in Kalamazoo, Michigan, where she played volleyball for four years and was selected to the All-Mid-American Conference team in 1979. She received a Bachelor of Science degree with honors in computer science from WMU in 1982.

Prior to coming to USI, VanHall coached volleyball in Michigan at Kalamazoo College Schoolcraft High School. Returning to Evansville, VanHall coached at Bosse High School in Evansville for two years. She also coached a USVBA club team for five years.
