1. American Thought Class Visits New Harmony

Miss Helen Elliott, a resident of New Harmony and an authority upon its Rappite and Owenite origins, entertained Dr. Donald E. Pitzer and his class in American Thought at her home on November 18, 1969. Miss Elliott, whose family has lived at New Harmony since the 1920's, presented a lecture on the history of the ideas that created the town and conducted a tour of the major points of interest. At the library archives the students were shown publications dating to the days of the Owenite Community which are open for research projects.
