A special dental clinic for school-age children will be conducted by students and faculty of the University of Southern Indiana dental hygiene and dental assisting programs in cooperation with the Evansville Coalition for the Homeless (ECHO) on February 17 and 18 at the St. Anthony's Center for Family Life, 713 2nd Avenue.

Dental sealant applications will be performed by dental hygiene students, assisted by dental assisting students, under USI staff dentist and faculty supervision.

"February is Childrens' Dental Health Month," said Deborah Henry, director of the dental hygiene program at USI. "We felt providing the clinic was a worthwhile community service which would allow a good clinical experience for our students."

Approximately 40 children are expected to participate in the dental clinic.
