This series will be transmitted via Indiana Higher Education Telecommunications System (IHETS) 2:30-3:30 p. m. on Wednesday afternoons in Lecture Hall 126. All faculty and students are encouraged to attend this series of programs.

Programs included in the series are:

- March 4 - "The What and Why of Black Studies." Interviews with directors of Black Studies program from several Indiana colleges and Universities.
- March 11- "Perspectives in Black Literature." A close-up look at several significant works by outstanding black authors.
- March 18- "Black Poetry." A program presented by Mari Evans, Poet-in-residence.
- April 1 - "Ghetto Language."
- April 8 - "Cool Medium." Jazz, "soul" and blues performed by the Dave Baker Trio of I.S.
- April 15- "Inter-cultural Relationships: The Situation." Relationships of black and white students in the dormitory, the classroom and on the campus.
- April 22- "Black Renaissance in the 20th Century." "A Focus on Harlem." The cultural and intellectual center of the black community in the United States is explored.
- April 29- "Inter-cultural Relationships: Evaluation."
- May 6- "Racism." The history and development of racism in the United States, including student, faculty and community reactions to this problem.
- May 13 - "Black-White Community Relationships." An on-the-scene program which observes the black-white Terre Haute community in action.
- May 20 - "A Balance Sheet of the Situation."
- May 27 - "Summary Program."
