1. 1970 Fall Meeting for Faculty and Administrative Staff
 Wednesday, September 9, 1970, at 8:30 a. m. there will be a coffee followed by a meeting at 9:00 a. m. for new Faculty and returning Faculty and Administrative Staff in Room 34.

Packets for pre-advised students will not be held past 12:00 noon on September 16. All other students will register on September 16 from 1:00 p. m. until 5:00 p. m.
