## Kenneth Sendelweck is featured Executive-in-Residence

Mr. Kenneth L. Sendelweck, president and chief executive officer of German American Bank in Jasper and a 1976 graduate of University of Southern Indiana, will present the spring Executive-in-Residence lecture for the USI School of Business. His topic will be "Financial Services in the New Millennium...Community Style?"

The lecture will be held at 9 a.m. and 11 a.m. on Wednesday, March 29, in Carter Hall, University Center. The lecture is free and open to the public. Sendelwick will meet with business students, faculty, and administrators in other sessions throughout the day.
