

Meditation Path to be dedicated on USI campus

The public is invited to an outdoor mass at 11 a.m. Sunday, August 25, on the University of Southern Indiana campus, planned in conjunction with the dedication of Meditation Path, a 600-foot installation through a wooded area connecting Parking Lot B to University Housing. The mass and dedication will be held at the site off Parking Lot B.

Meditation path features a statue of St. Francis, the Beattitudes in signage, and scattered benches. The installation was supervised by Brian Knapp, a Mater Dei senior who is working toward his Eagle Scout badge.

The path will be dedicated to Brian's grandfather, long-time West Side scouting leader Bert Miller who died earlier this year. Brian is the son of Mary Helen and Dr. Allan Knapp, an Evansville dentist and 1973 USI biology graduate.
