Dr. James E. Vaught will give the keynote address at the Indiana State University Evansville dental assistants graduation on May 8, 1973. Dr. Vaught is the Director of Dental Auxiliary Education at Indiana University School of Dentistry, Indianapolis, Indiana.

Dr. Vaught graduated from Indiana State University in 1957 with Bachelor of Science degree and completed his formal education at the Indiana University School of Dentistry where he earned the D.D.S. degree in 1961.

From 1961 to 1967 Dr. Vaught was an assistant dental officer with United States Navy and was promoted to dental officer in 1967. In 1968 Dr. Vaught was a postdoctoral fellow with Naval Dental Center in San Deigo, California.

After his naval duty, Dr. Vaught was Professor and Chairman of the Department of Dental Hygiene, College of Health, at East Tennessee State University for four years.

As Director of Curriculum Development for State-Wide Auxiliary Programs and Chairman of Curriculum Committee, Dental Auxiliary Programs, Indiana University, Dr. Vaught is involved in planning of dental auxiliary programs throughout the State of Indiana.

The 1973 dental assistant class is the second class to graduate through the Indiana State University Evansville program. Fifteen girls
