## **Wayne County student going to South Korea next fall in university exchange program**

Carrie Sheets, a University of Southern Indiana (USI) junior and Wayne County resident, will attend Keimyung University in Korea next fall as part of a university exchange program between the two universities.

Keimyung University has established exchange programs with about forty universities in various countries, offering intensive courses in Korean studies. Keimyung University has an enrollment of 20,000 students. USI is located in Evansville, Indiana, with an enrollment of 7,555 students.

Dr. Sang T. Choe, USI professor of marketing, was on the Keimyung University faculty last semester in a faculty exchange program and is coordinating details of the student trip. Evan R. Hiple of Grant County, a USI sophomore, also has been selected to the program.

A 1993 Lincoln Jr./Sr. High School graduate, Sheets is a Presidential Scholar at USI, a member of Collegiate Republicans, a USI Student Government Association representative, and executive director of the Political Science Organization. Her major is political science and she is a consistent dean's list student. She holds membership in two campus honoraries, Alpha Chi and Phi Sigma Alpha.
