9. Faculty Member and ISUE Honored

ISUE feels honored that one of our faculty members, Mr. J. Maxwell Davis, has been invited by President Nixon to participate in a meeting to study the problems of Food, Nutrition and Health. The meeting will be held in Washington, D. C. December 2, 3, and 3, 1969.

This group will meet with 2500 people to work on plans for the U. S. to make sure everyone knows what to eat, how to purchase, and how to prepare the food for the best nutritional benefits. To tell the Government where the money comes from, how to educate the people and formalize classes to study the health programs. Re-train teachers and make sure future curricular has a strong nutritional science built into it so future teachers will be able to better teach nutrition. Educate the plants to label the food they sell for human consumption at least as well as they label dog food. The group will present their program and defend their claims.
