Dr. Sandor Szilassy, Head Librarian and Associate Professor, published a well documented research article in the Spring, 1969, issue of East European Quarterly, which is a publication of the University of Colorado. The topic of the article is of the Austro-Hungarian Empire at the end of World War I. Earlier this year another of his papers, concerning with Hungarian peace efforts in 1939, was printed in the Quarterly UI Patohatar, (Munich, Germany).

As a recognition of Dr. Szilassy's long and distinguished service in historical research and scholarship, recently he was awarded a Certificate of Merit by the Dictionary of International Biography in London, England.
