St. Phillips Road, Poseyville, is among 14 students at the University of Southern Indiana who have been chosen national outstanding campus leaders and will be included in the 1988 edition of Who's Who Among Students in American Universities and Colleges.

Campus nominating committees and editors of the annual directory chose the students on the basis of their academic achievement, service to the community, leadership in extracurricular activities, and potential for continued success. The USI students join an elite group selected from more than 1,400 institutions of higher learning in all 50 states, the District of Columbia, and several foreign nations.

Deal-Reese is vice president of the USI Accounting Club and League of Professional Women and also a member of the Data Processing Management Association and Alpha Chi National Honor Society, and campus representative of Becker CPA Review. She has been active on campus in the Christian Rural Overseas Program and various activities of the Accounting Club, League of Professional Women, and DPMA.

In the community, she has been a representative to the American Cancer Society, a volunteer with American Red Cross, a Sunday School and Bible School teacher, and a member of her church's volleyball team.

Her honors have included Indiana CPA Educational Foundation Scholarship finalist; USI Academic, USI Alumni, Thomas Alexander, Hoosier, and League of Professional Women scholarships; and the USI Dean's List. She has a 3.9 overall grade point average out of a possible 4.0.
