### **FRAGILE HARMONY OPENS AT MUSEUM**

*Fragile Harmony*, a collaborative exhibition of photography and poetry by two University of Southern Indiana faculty members, will open Sunday, April 5, at the Evansville Museum of Arts and Science.

The exhibition by Eric Braysmith, part-time lecturer in art and English who teaches photography and film studies, and Matthew R. Graham, associate professor of creative writing, will be available in the Museum's Contemporary Gallery through May 17. A reception for the two artists will be held from 6 to 8 p.m. on Friday, May 8.

*Fragile Harmony* is a discovery, documentation, and interpretation of southern Indiana, the result of a year and a half of travel by the artists along an historic corridor of the state. One of the poems Graham wrote for *Fragile Harmony* will be published in the spring issue of *The Indiana Review*.

The *Fragile Harmony* project was made possible by a grant from the family of James B. Igleheart, and by funding from USI and Historic Southern Indiana Project.
