MED-SCHOOL BOUND STUDENTS RECOGNIZED IN USI HONORS DAY

The prestigious Trustees Distinguished Merit Award and the Melvin Denner Health Professions Award were presented Tuesday, March 23, to Presidential Scholars at the University of Southern Indiana, as the 1993 Honors Week recognized student excellence in the School of Science and Engineering Technology.

Sondra K. Wolf of 2415 John Court, Evansville, the 1990 Harrison High School salutatorian and recipient of the Fred Newman Family Presidential Scholarship, was selected for the Trustees Award. Each of the five USI Schools nominate a top student for the \$1,000 award. Wolf is a biology major who has completed her studies at USI in three years and has been accepted by the Indiana University School of Medicine.

Patricia A. Godeke of 851 S. Villa, Evansville, received the \$1,000 Denner Award presented annually to a senior who has been accepted in a doctoral-granting institution in health professions. A biology major, she will continue her studies in the IU School of Medicine. She was 1989 Bosse High School valedictorian and is the Industrial Contractors Presidential Scholar.

The \$2,300 David L. Rice Scholarship was among other major awards Tuesday, presented for the third year to junior chemistry major **Kim B. Foltz**, a 1990 graduate of Evansville Day School who lives at 129 Cortez in Chandler, Indiana. A chemistry major who plans to enter research, she also received a \$750 USI Alumni Association Scholarship; the \$400 O. John Logsdon Chemistry Scholarship, also an academic merit award; and a \$300 Mead Johnson Scholarship.

The \$2,200 John Edgar George Memorial Scholarship was presented to **Tyrone Taylor**, a 1991 Harrison High School graduate who lives at 1612 Polster. He is a sophomore mathematics major.

Michelle A. Scott, 1900 S. Governor, Evansville, received the \$1,500 Herschel Moore Memorial Scholarship awarded to a single black woman in recognition of her potential to succeed in her chosen field. She is a secondary mathematics education major and a forward on the USI women's basketball team.

Ronda L. Jerrell of RR 3, Linton, Indiana, a junior pre-med biology major, received a \$750 USI Alumni Association Scholarship and the \$500 Albert A. Woll Memorial Scholarship.

The Robert and Elaine Pott Foundation Scholarships went to 24 engineering students. The awards provide up to \$1,600 per student annually, to assure that their tuition is covered, and are renewable so long as grades are maintained. The 1993 recipients are:
