## Guided trip to England

Dr. Sherry Darrell, University of Southern Indiana professor of English, and Dr. Robert Darrell, professor of English at Kentucky Wesleyan University, will lead an educational tour of England from July 18 to August 1, 2001. The cost for a single ticket is \$2,835; \$2,455 each for two. The cost includes round-trip airfare from Louisville, hotel accommodations, sightseeing tours and transfers by private coach, a full English breakfast, and a three-course dinner every evening, served in the hotel.

Participants on this 15-day trip will begin site seeing in London and journey as far north as York, visiting Kent, Brighton, North Wales, and more. The tour participants will explore famous sites in London such as the Tower of London, Westminster Abbey, and Buckingham Palace, as well as great churches, cathedrals, and other modern sites.

Road trips will encompass other parts of England including such historical sights as Stonehenge, Canterbury Cathedral, Crystal Palace, and Dover Castle. Participants will visit Roman baths in Bristol and enjoy full day tours of Snowdonia National Park and North Wales. Free time is scheduled throughout the trip for personal interests, golf, and shopping.

"The group will see important manuscripts and artifacts as well as enjoy varied drama and architecture," said Dr. Sherry Darrel. "Bob and I have led groups of students and adults over the past 10 years to England, Canada, France, and Italy so we're seasoned travelers and know how to make every second count."
