I.S.U.E. EMPLOYEES BLOOD BANK

Applications for members in the I.S.U.E. Blood Bank are being accepted now. If you wish to enroll, complete the attached form and return it to the Student Health Services, Room 116. If you are now a member and wish to continue as such there is no need to reapply, however, if you wish to discontinue membership, please send a memo indicating this.

MEMBERSHIP:

- a. Open to all Faculty and Staff of I.S.U.E., including active Adjunct Faculty.
- b. Termination of employment terminates membership.

COVERAGE:

Includes the member, his (her) immediate family and his (her) dependents (as claimed on federal income tax returns).

PROCEDURE:

If blood is needed for a person covered by this plan, the member indicates membership in the I.S.U.E. Blood Bank to the hospital representative who contacts I.S.U.E. to verify coverage.

Donors are then selected from the membership list of the I.S.U.E. blood bank for repayment.

Donors will be selected on a rotational basis.

ADVANTAGES OF MEMBERSHIP:

1. Ready availability of donors is assured.
2. Coverage includes dependents as well as the member's immediate family.
3. Coverage exists not only in Evansville, but also anywhere there is a member bank of the American Association of Blood Banks or the Red Cross.
4. Donation of a unit of blood is no longer required to initiate membership. The member is required to replace a unit of blood when requested; if the member declines, he is removed from the membership list.
5. Replacement of a unit of blood is made in one of the following ways:
  - a. The member donates a unit of blood.
  - b. A representative of the member (friend or relative) donates a unit of blood.
  - c. A member pays the hospital blood bank a fee to cover the cost of a unit of blood.
