BUS SCHEDULE

INDIANA STATE UNIVERSITY

Buses will be running, starting at 7:25 a.m., over the following route:

The bus will start at Ninth and Locusts behind the Civic Center adjacent to the Civic Center parking lot.

The bus will leave from the parking lot every 30 (thirty) minutes until 12:25 (noon) then it will leave at 1:25, 2:25, 3:25 and 4:25 p.m.

It will go down Main Street to Third, down Third to Court, down Court to Market to Pennsylvania and First Avenue, down Pennsylvania to I.S.U.E.

The bus will make stops at all points along this route and will return along the same route.

The last bus will leave the University at 5:20 p.m.

This schedule is subject to change upon further information indicating a more coordinated schedule according to class schedules.

Student fares will be forty (40) cents per trip, or bus passes will be available at the rate of \$12.00 (twelve) per month. These passes are good at any time in any one month.
