## **Marcie Obermeyer to study in England this fall**

Marcie Obermeyer, a junior at the University of Southern Indiana and former Oldenburg Academy student, will participate in one of the study abroad programs offered through USI, spending the 1997 fall semester at Harlaxton College in Grantham, England.

Obermeyer is the daughter of Edward and Mary Jane Obermeyer, 23121 Vote Road, Batesville, Indiana. An English major, she came to USI on a cross country scholarship and will follow a training schedule while pursuing her studies in England. She will rejoin the USI track team when she returns in January.

Harlaxton College is a self-contained campus in a 100-room Victorian manor house in central England. Owned and operated by the University of Evansville, it serves as a study abroad program for students and faculty at a select group of U.S. colleges. About 175 American students attend Harlaxton each semester. USI students will begin participating for the first time during the 1997 fall semester.

USI also offers students the opportunity to study at universities located in Germany, South Korea, Bangladesh, Jordan, Israel, Canada, Mexico, and Japan.
