## 1999 USI Volleyball Outlook

“Start strong and finish strong.”

This is what University of Southern Indiana volleyball Head Coach **Kelly Boyd** wants of her team in the 1999 season.

In 1998, the Screaming Eagles were 12-15 overall and finished fifth in the Great Lakes Valley Conference's Green Division with a 4-12 league mark. The key to why the Eagles finished below .500 was in the first game of each match.

The Eagles were 10-0 when they won the first game of the match, but 2-15 when they lost game one. Also USI started the year 3-0, but was 0-6 in the final six matches of the year.

To meet the challenge in 1999, Boyd will have to replace four starters and two reserves, but she has two of the best players in USI history to build upon.

Junior setter **Carly Messman** (Ft. Wayne, Indiana) will challenge the USI all-time record for assists this fall. Messman, who led the team with 885 assists, has 1,679 career assists, needing 474 to break the all-time record of 2,152 held by Michelle Weesies.

Setting up the ball is not the only thing Messman can do. She also had a .151 hitting percentage with 89 kills and was fifth on the team with 19 aces as a sophomore.

Joining Messman in moving up the all-time charts is senior outside hitter **Danielle Peter** (Tell City, Indiana). Peter led the Eagles in kills with 300 (3.2 per game), 38 aces, and 290 digs in 1999.

In her career, Peter ranks fourth all-time in digs and fifth all-time in kills.

A third upperclassman returning for the 1999 season is junior outside hitter/designated hitter **Emily McIntosh** (Monroeville, Indiana). McIntosh, who saw more and more playing time as the 1998 season progressed, was third on the team with 21 aces and 216 digs. She also had 122 kills (1.3 per game).

Returning for their second season with the Eagles are four sophomores.

On the front row, returning to the Eagles are outside hitters **Ivy Krom** (Rochester, Indiana), **Jan Johnson** (Bloomfield, Indiana), and **Kristi Dukes** (Kendallville, Indiana).

Dukes saw action as a freshman, playing in 18 matches with a .142 hitting percentage with 59 kills.

Krom saw limited action in seven matches, while Johnson played in one match before missing the remainder of the season with an illness.

On the backline will be sophomore defensive specialist **Eileen Stahura** (Whiting, Indiana). Stahura became a valuable member of the USI defense, playing in 26 of the 27 matches with 103 digs (1.2 per game).

Bolstering the depth of the team, Boyd has seven new recruits to mesh with the veterans. She is adding two setters, two middle hitters, and two outside hitters.

Two of the newcomers are no strangers to USI athletics. Sophomore middle hitter **Liz Prewett** (Washington, Indiana) and outside hitter **Leah Mercer** (Evansville, Indiana) transferred to the volleyball team after two years with the women's basketball program.

A third sophomore player is setter **Natalie Emge** (Evansville, Indiana), who transferred after playing one season for the Depauw University volleyball team.

The four freshmen who will join Emge, Mercer and Prewett as newcomers are setter **Shannon Wells** (Merrillville, Indiana); outside hitters **Kristina Kavanaugh** (Montgomery, Indiana) and **Jami Turner**

(Muncie, Indiana); and middle hitter **Kristin Allison** (Indianapolis, Indiana).

USI has a tough GLVC schedule this year, facing three conference teams who participated in last year's NCAA Division II Tournament. Last year was the first time the league sent three teams to the national tournament.

USI will host Indiana University/Purdue University Ft. Wayne on October 1 and Northern Kentucky University, who went to the NCAA II Elite Eight, on November 5. The Eagles will travel to NKU on October 9 and to Southern Illinois University Edwardsville on October 22.



# Kelly Boyd

## Volleyball Head Coach

Kelly Boyd, all-time winningest volleyball coach at the University of Southern Indiana, is looking forward to a winning season in 1999. Boyd, who holds the longest tenure of any volleyball coach at USI since the program's inception, is 106-96 (.537) in seven seasons with the Screaming Eagles.

A year removed from finishing second in the Great Lakes Valley Conference's Green Division, the Eagles finished last season 12-15, 4-12 GLVC. With three starters returning, Boyd expects USI to make another trip to the conference tournament.

Boyd became USI's all-time winningest volleyball coach in 1995, a season that saw the Eagles go 14-15 overall, 9-11 GLVC, and miss the GLVC Tournament by one match. Overall, she has led the USI to four winning seasons and four appearances in the GLVC Tournament.

During her first year as head volleyball coach, Boyd led the Eagles to a 14-13 mark and

a 5-4 GLVC record, finishing in the upper-half of the division. During 1992 and 1993, she was an assistant coach on the women's basketball team in addition to being the head volleyball coach.

While a graduate assistant coach for women's basketball at Eastern Kentucky University in Richmond, Kentucky, Boyd earned her master's degree in physical education/sports administration. The native of Argenta, Illinois, earned an associate's degree from Lincoln College while playing varsity basketball and softball. She went on to receive a bachelor's degree in physical education in 1990 from Truman State University (formerly Northeast Missouri State University), where she continued her varsity basketball career from 1987-90.

In addition to her duties as volleyball coach, Boyd teaches in the USI Physical Education Department.
