With the approach of the 50th anniversary of the Japanese attack on Pearl Harbor and U.S. entry into World War II, a special noncredit course examining the pre-war period is being offered at the University of Southern Indiana.

"Countdown to Pearl Harbor" will be taught by Dr. Darrel E. Bigham, USI professor of history. The class will meet six Tuesday afternoons, October 29-December 3, at Solarbron Pointe, 1501 McDowell Road. It will cover the period from September 1939 to December 7, 1941, focusing on factors that drew the U.S. into the war. Special attention will be given to recollections of class participants who lived through that period. The registration fee is \$38.

The class is among several fall/winter noncredit courses offered by the Office of Continuing Education which still have openings. Among others are:

Computer courses -- Advanced Disk Operating System for hard-disk users, Wednesday, October 30, fee \$68; Advanced WordPerfect, five sessions starting Monday, October 28, fee \$135.

Parenting -- Beginning Phonics for Parents, Tuesday evening, October 29, fee \$20.

Professional development -- Ross Van Ness, professor of adult and community education at Ball State University, will conduct two courses: Planning and Organizing Your Time and Your Work, Thursday, October 31; Problem Solving and Decision Making Techniques, Friday, November 1; fee \$95 each.

Professional development -- six courses in the Certificate in Management series: What Managers Do, six Tuesdays starting October 29; two six-week sections on Communications Skills for Managers, one starting Tuesday, October 29, and the second starting Thursday, October 31; Leadership Skills for Managers, six Mondays starting October 28; Women in Management, six Wednesdays starting October 30; and Negotiating Your Way To Success, six Thursdays starting October 31; fees are \$160 for each course.

Professional Development -- Current Topics for Accountants, Saturday, November 2, fee \$95; Power Strategies for Professional Women, Saturday, November 2, \$115; Winning Lifestyles for Supervisors and Managers, Saturday, November 2, \$95.
