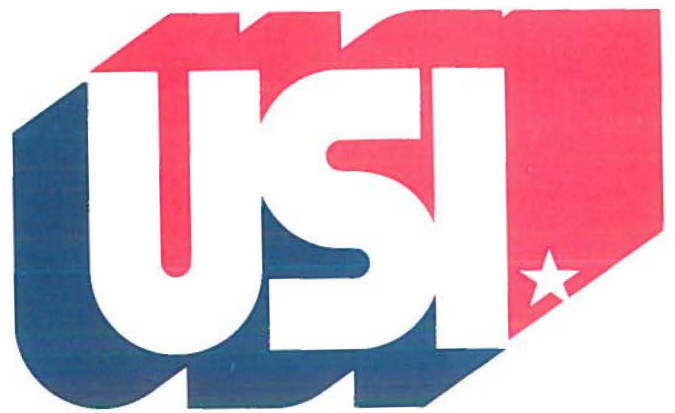


FINAL WORKSHOP SLATED

A workshop on communicating with people -- the last of a series of four inaugurating University of Southern Indiana programs in the Jasper area this fall -- will be held Wednesday, December 2, at the Southern Hills Counseling Center.

Dr. Sandra M. Singer, USI associate professor of psychology and director of the Evansville Graduate Studies Center, will lead the day-long workshop, "Successfully Managing People." It will focus on understanding people, using the right motivational techniques, managing conflict, increasing productivity, and contracting with others for performance improvements. A closing question-answer period will give participants an opportunity to discuss specific problems.
