USI to host symposium on Mendelssohn's "Elijah" oratorio ahead of Evansville Philharmonic Orchestra performance

The University of Southern Indiana, in cooperation with the Evansville Philharmonic Orchestra, will host a symposium focused on the Felix Mendelssohn-composed oratorio *Elijah* at 7 p.m. Wednesday, February 24 in Kleymeyer Hall inside the Liberal Arts Center. The presentation is free and open to the public.

Presenters at the symposium include:

- Dr. James Ware, professor of philosophy and religion at the University of Evansville, speaking on "Elijah in the Bible and in the Oratorio."
- Rabbi Gary Mazo of Temple Adath B'nai Israel, speaking on "Elijah's Role in the Jewish Tradition."
- Father Joseph Ziliak, Vicar for Retired Priests for the Catholic Diocese of Evansville, speaking on "Elijah in the Christian Tradition."
- Alfred Savia, Evansville Philharmonic Orchestra music director, speaking on "Musical Examples from Mendelssohn's Oratorio."
- Dr. Shannon Pritchard, assistant professor of art history at USI, speaking on "Italian Renaissance and Baroque Art."
