The USI Foundation at the University of Southern Indiana is coordinating an effort to raise \$5,000 to help the Hoehn family of New Harmony with the long-distance telephone bills and other other extraordinary expenses incurred in their effort to secure the safety of Joan Hoehn Khaja, and her daughter, Janon, 2, and son, Basil, 1.

The University has entered into the effort because Mrs. Khaja is related to four USI employees -- a sister, Chris Hoehn, is assistant director of Campus Ministry; a brother and sister-in-law, Dan and Cindy Hoehn, are Physical Plant employees; and another sister-in-law, Nancy Hoehn, is a secretary in the Admissions Office.

Another sister, Pauline Hoehn Gerard, and her husband, Scott, have spearheaded the effort to bring Mrs. Khaja home from Kuwait. She had taken the children to visit her husband's family when she became caught up in the events of the Iraqi invasion of Kuwait. Mrs. Khaja is seven months along in what had been a problem pregnancy.
