"Surfin' USI" is the theme for a week of orientation activities planned for new students entering the University of Southern Indiana for the fall semester.

Family orientation day will be Sunday, August 18, when parents and other family members are invited to join the students in learning about the University. The day's events will start with the Catholic liturgy at 10 a.m. in Eicher Barn or an interdenominational service at 11 a.m. under the big tent on the University Center lawn. A picnic lunch will follow. Orientation will begin at 1 p.m. and end by 4 p.m. with a reception at the University Home. The movie *Flatliners* will be shown at 9 p.m. in Forum I.

Monday will be new student orientation day. The 8 a.m. program in the Physical Activities Center will feature Dr. Will Kiem discussing the joys and pitfalls of entering college. New adult students may attend adult orientation at 1 or 6 p.m. in Forum II of the Administration Building.

The Fall Faculty and Administrative Staff meeting will be held at 8:30 a.m. Monday in Forum I, with new faculty orientation slated at 8 a.m. Tuesday.

Placement testing for new students will be at 8 a.m. Tuesday and the Executive Queen will take a group of 300 on an Ohio River cruise at 2 p.m.

Final new student registration will begin at 8:30 a.m. Wednesday and open registration, 8:30 a.m. Thursday. Other events those days include *The Naked Gun*, to be shown outdoors near the Physical Activities Center at 9 p.m. Wednesday, and the AMIGOs' (Ask Me I Give Orientation) wacky Olympics, 4 to 6 p.m. Thursday.

A "Surfin' USI" beach party will be start at 10 a.m. Friday at Burdette Park. The annual orientation dance at 8 p.m. will close the week's activities and fall classes will begin on Monday, August 26.
