Kevin Titzer wins "Best of Show" in USI Student Art show

Kevin Titzer, a junior art major from Evansville, won the Old National Bank "Best of Show" award in the 1996 Student Art Show at the University of Southern Indiana. Juror James Tanner of Mankato State University selected all five of Titzer's entries — sculptures in wood and other media — for the \$350 award and also selected the Titzer works for the \$150 Old National Bank scholarship.

More than 400 art works were submitted for the 1996 show, with Tanner selecting 125 for display and awards. Each student could enter up to five pieces. The 1996 show remains on display from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. daily through Sunday, April 21, in the University Conference Center. Other multiple awards went to:
