MULTICULTURAL WEEK TO BE FEATURED IN USI PROGRAMS

The Liberal Arts Forum and Political Science Club at the University of Southern Indiana are sponsoring "Multicultural Week," when three USI faculty members will discuss and show pictures of their overseas travels.

The programs will be held at 2:45 p.m. Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday, October 19-20-21, in Forum III. They are open to the public.

Dr. Robert L. Reid, vice president for Academic Affairs and professor of history, will open the series with a discussion of his trip to China earlier this year.

Dr. Walter W. Jermakowicz, associate professor of business who spent the first half of 1993 helping with government reorganization in his native Poland, will discuss "Changes in Russia" on the second day.

Dr. Charles T. Barber, chairperson of the Philosophy and Political Science Department and professor of political science, will discuss Syria and the Mid East during the third program.
