ADDITIONAL ENGINEERING PROGRAMS ACCREDITED. The Division of Engineering Technology of Indiana State University Evansville has received official notification that its baccalaureate programs in civil engineering technology, mechanical engineering technology, and electrical engineering technology have been accredited by the Engineering Accreditation Commission of the Accreditation Board for Engineering and Technology (ABET), formerly the Engineers' Council for Professional Development. The baccalaureate program in mining engineering technology and associate degree programs in civil engineering technology, mechanical engineering technology, and electrical engineering technology were accredited by ABET in 1980.
