The University of Southern Indiana Office of Continuing Education has received tickets for the "White Oak Dance Project," featuring Mikhail Baryshnikov at the Kentucky Center for the Arts in Louisville.

The program of contemporary dance is sponsored by the Louisville Ballet. Ten of the country's finest modern dancers will perform four works created by Mark Morris, one of today's most ingenious choreographers. Although Baryshnikov performs in all four pieces, he is not the only star. Hand-picked by Baryshnikov and Morris, these performers draw from established careers in either ballet or modern dance backgrounds, and blend the two forms in a unique dance experience.

Only two performances will be available in the Louisville area, on May 17 and 18. USI is arranging a bus trip for Friday evening, May 17, to include dinner, the performance, and immediate return to Evansville. The cost will depend on dinner arrangements, which still are being completed.
