Upon the recommendation of the Hon. Roger H. Zion, the Library of ISUE has been designated a depository for United States Government publications. It enables members of the faculty and the library staff to select series and other items from a list of the Superintendent of Documents free of charge.

The Federal Government publishes more than 30,000 titles each year, and although the handling of these publications is complicated, the invested time and effort will bring great benefits to the campus community. Less than 20% of college and university libraries have depository status, and this is an honor as well as recognition of our library development program.
