Several computer courses are among the summer schedule of noncredit classes which still have openings at the University of Southern Indiana.

The computer courses include intermediate and advanced Disk Operating System (DOS) sections, starting Tuesday, June 9, and Wednesday, June 10, respectively; two classes on the WordPerfect word-processing program, starting Monday, June 8, and Thursday, June 11; an introductory Lotus 1-2-3 course which starts Wednesday, June 10; and a one-evening explanation of how to buy a computer -- and why, slated Tuesday, June 9. "Computer Basics for Beginners," a five-session class for 7- to 9-year-olds which starts Monday, June 8, also is still available.

The Springboard Diving Camp slated Monday-Friday, June 8-12, and two physical fitness programs -- "Body Toning for Women" and "Water Aerobics," both starting Monday, June 8 -- also have openings. Springboard diving is open to boys and girls who will enter grades 7 through 12; both residential and commuter registration is available.
