USI computer courses include new introductory

In addition to the usual lineup of introductory computer courses offered this spring by the University of Southern Indiana Office of Continuing Education, the noncredit program will feature a series of single-session courses to introduce the novice -- whether just starting on computers or just starting a new program -- to the variety of basic computer applications.

The sessions will provide hands-on experience with networked IBM microcomputers, and cover computer basics, what the user can and cannot do, simple programming concepts, and the English equivalent for common computer jargon. Participants will receive information on USI computer courses that will help them expand their capabilities.

Pick a 2 and 2/1-hour session from the following: Monday evening, January 30; Thursday evening, February 2; Saturday morning, February 11; Saturday afternoon, February 11; and Saturday morning, March 25. The registration fee is \$24.

Other spring courses will cover DOS, Windows, word processing, networks and Internet, and Lotus. Fees vary by program, but the majority are \$37 for a three-hour course. Call the Office of Continuing Education, 812/464-1989 or 800/467-8600, for information or to register.
