INSTRUCTOR NAMED OUTSTANDING YOUNG WOMAN OF INDIANA. Glenda Miller, instructor in dental assisting, has been named Indiana's Outstanding Young Woman of 1982. Ms. Miller is the daughter of Marilou Tapp and Harold Harman. She is the wife of Steven W. Miller and the mother of two children.

Ms. Miller's biography and record of accomplishments will appear in the 1982 awards volume Outstanding Young Women of America. The Outstanding Young Women of America program, sponsored annually by leaders of women's organizations, honors young women between the ages of 21 and 36 for civic and professional achievement. A distinguished Board of Advisors guides the program. Mrs. Dexter Otis Arnold, honorary president of the General Federation of Women's Clubs is chairwoman of the Board, which includes national presidents of many major women's organizations.

Ms. Miller has several years' experience as a chairside and reception dental assistant. She received her training at ISUE and is currently a candidate for a BS in Health Services. She is a member of the American Dental Assistant Association and was a delegate to the national convention in 1977 and 1982. She has held many leadership positions in the Indiana Dental Assistants Association, as well as in the Evansville Dental Assistant Society. Her humanitarian interests include the Muscular Dystrophy Association Telethon and working as a new member of Infa-Life Seekers. Many of her works have been published, and she has won many awards in the Indiana Dental Assistant Association.


