DUANE KEITEL PRESENTED TRUSTEES MERIT AWARD

Duane L. Keitel, senior chemistry major and pre-med student who has been accepted by the Indiana University School of Medicine for graduate studies, was presented the USI Board of Trustees Distinguished Merit Award during the School of Science and Engineering Technology Honors Week program.

Keitel, son of David and DeeAnn Keitel, 623 E. 10th, Mt. Vernon, is a 1990 graduate of Mt. Vernon High School. He was class valedictorian and attends USI as a Presidential Scholar. He has achieved a perfect 4.0 grade point average at the University. The Trustees Award is an unrestricted \$1,000 cash grant. He also received the American Chemical Society, Indiana-Kentucky Border Section Student Achievement Award and the Academic Achievement Award in Chemistry.

Students in the School of Liberal Arts, School of Nursing and Health Professions, and School of Science and Engineering Technology were honored Monday through Wednesday. Award winners in the School of Business and School of Education and Human Services will be listed next week. Several nontraditional (adult) students won major or multiple awards that will help them continue in school.

Diana Hinesley Zintel of Evansville won the \$1,000 Communal Studies Prize, and also was selected for the Mirabella Achievement Award, the latter awarded in a competition among top students in key areas in the School of Liberal Arts.. Zintel, whose son Joshua is a psychology major at USI, is a 1972 Indianapolis high school graduate and transferred from IU/PU-Indianapolis. She is maintaining a 3.95 grade point average (out of a possible 4.0) at USI where she is a history major and also received the Academic Achievement Award in United States History.

Anne B. Peery of Vincennes, Indiana, a 1967 high school graduate, also is a nontraditional transferee whose work in geology prompted school officials to find a way to help her stay in class. She received the Walter F. Sill Memorial Scholarship in Geology, which pays full tuition.

Ruth Metzger, an Evansville nurse who is continuing her education, won numerous awards in nursing including a \$750 USI Alumni Association Scholarship, the \$500 Pamela Grubb Memorial Scholarship, and a \$500 Edward F. Harrison Scholarship. A 1972 graduate of Marian Heights Academy, her parents live in Owensboro, Kentucky.
