Video and Interview Opportunities

The annual Health Professions Job Fair will be held on Monday, October 31 at the University of Southern Indiana from 1:30 p.m. to 4:30 p.m. in the Physical Activities Center (PAC). Recruiters from hospitals, physical rehabilitation centers, psychiatric facilities, nursing homes, and home health-care agencies will be on campus to talk with nursing students and students in other health-related fields. Recruiters from the Tri-State, central and northern Indiana, Michigan, Tennessee, Missouri and Ohio have registered for the Job Fair.

Recruiters and students will be available for comments. Recruiters could answer questions about the future of careers in the health care professions; the role of the home health agencies, a future trend as hospital stays are shortened due to insurance issues; and what kind of individuals they are hoping to hire.

Students can address such issues as what health care fields they hope to enter and what expectations they have about their chosen careers.

Tracy Powers, the coordinator of the Health Professions Job Fair and Assistant Director of USI Career Services, will be at the registration table to help you locate persons to interview. Approximately 70 recruiters and 300 students are expected to attend. The Job Fair is the first event in Career Week, which runs all week. Ms. Powers can comment on the other events planned throughout the week.
