BLUE CROSS/BLUE SHIELD INFORMATION. Blue Cross/Blue Shield premium rates will be increased effective October 1, 1982, due to the inflation of medical costs and increased claims. Staff members will continue to pay 25 percent of the premium and the University will contribute 75 percent of the cost. The new rates for staff members with Blue Cross/Blue Shield coverage are as follows:

Also, October is the open enrollment month for Blue Cross/Blue Shield health insurance. This enrollment period is made available to all employees who have not previously enrolled themselves or their dependents in the group health insurance program. Those staff members who wish to take advantage of this opportunity should contact the Personnel Office. Coverage will become effective November 1, 1982, if the necessary forms are completed and a cash payment is made by Friday, October 22, 1982. For employees who choose to wait to begin payment by payroll deduction, the effective date of the health insurance will be December 1, 1982. Be sure to contact the Personnel Office before October 22, 1982, for open enrollment information.
