6. English 311

English 311 is required of all ISUE students who fail to pass the English Proficiency Exam or who do not have a B+ average in Freshman English or who elect to take the 311 course instead of the Proficiency Exam.

The Exam will be given on April 16th, Wednesday, from 10:00 a. m. until 12:00 noon, and again from 6:00 p. m. until 8:00 p. m. To be eligible for the Exam, a student must have completed 55 semester hours. Also to be eligible to enroll in English 311, a student must have completed 55 semester hours.

English majors and minors do not take the Exam or English 311. They must take English 310. Other majors and minors in Liberal Arts programs (such as Speech, Social Studies, Foreign Language, Philosophy, Humanities) are recommended to enroll in English 310.
