Several southern Indiana students placed in the tenth annual Speech Invitational sponsored recently by the University of Southern Indiana, with 11 Evansville and southern Indiana schools participating.

Reitz High School of Evansville again took top honors; Reitz students won one or both of the dual first-place slots in each of the 10 speech categories. Trophies were awarded to the three schools with the highest points. Mater Dei High School of Evansville won second place in team points; Evansville Harrison, third; North Posey, fourth; Evansville Bosse, fifth; and Evansville North, sixth.

Dr. Helen Sands, USI professor of communications, and Miss Mary Schroeder, assistant professor of communications, co-chaired the event. Seymour Brodsky, assistant professor of communications, was in charge of the broadcast section.
