Registration will be in the Physical Activities Center followed by concurrent sessions in Forums I, II, and III.

Dr. Gregory P. Valentine, assistant professor of business and director of the Center for Economic Education, said the students will attend sessions on job interviewing, teenage credit, how to succeed in college, and future technology and procedures for secretaries and office managers.
