Candidates for judge will answer questions at USI forum April 18

A public forum to introduce the Vanderburgh County Superior Court Juvenile and Probate Court judge candidates will be held at 7 p.m. in Carter Hall, on Tuesday, April 18, University Center at University of Southern Indiana.

The four candidates are Elaine Brown, Alan Hamilton, Jill Marcrum, and Brent Niemeier, all local attorneys. The public election will be held this fall.
