University of Southern Indiana ROTC cadet receives AFCEA scholarship

Sarah Banks, a senior math major at the University of Southern Indiana, has been awarded a \$2,000 Armed Forces Communications and Electronics Association (AFCEA) academic scholarship for the fall 2003 semester. The scholarship is awarded to cadets majoring in math, computers, or the sciences.

Banks is from Corydon, Indiana, and she is the daughter of Steve and Dawn Banks. She is a graduate of Corydon Central High School, and she works part-time in The Office of Institutional Research at USI.
