MID-AMERICA SINGERS PREPARE FOR 1993 MADRIGAL FEASTES

The University of Southern Indiana Mid-America Singers are in full rehearsal for the 24th annual Christmas Madrigal Feastes to be presented Thursday-Sunday, December 2-5, in the University Dining Room.

Guests for the 1993 festivities will dine on a traditional roast beef dinner, with each course presented in a procession led by the Mid-America Singers. Dinner will start at 7:30 p.m. Thursday, Friday, and Saturday, and at 6 p.m. Sunday.

Guests will be entertained by strolling singers and instrumentalists, juggling jesters, sneaky beggars, and serving wenches who enjoy flirting with the lords of the manor. Knights of the realm will compete to see who is noblest and strongest.

Daniel Craig, Singers director, said the evening is a scripted event inviting audience participation in "salt violations," carol singing, dancing, and interplay with the cast. The Singers will present a program of traditional Madrigal pieces from the Renaissance, stirring music from ancient to modern composers, and traditional carols from throughout the world, he said, noting this year's composers will include Giovanni Gastoldi, Hans Leo Hassler, Thomas Morley, John Dowland, and Franz Biebl.

Proceeds from USI's oldest tradition help support the Singers' costuming, music, travel, and competition costs. Tickets are \$19.50 for adults, \$14.50 for students and senior citizens. November 29 is the deadline for reservations.

A Royal Patron may purchase a \$50 ticket, with \$30 to be set aside for the Mid-America Singers and Band Fund in the USI Foundation. Patrons will enjoy special seating and will be listed in the program (ticket deadline: November 19).
