University of Southern Indiana offers multiple one-week Super Summer sessions and special enrichment courses for children of varying ages.

Programs available June 15 - 19 at USI include computers: World Wide Web discovery and learning word processing, spreadsheets, and graphic design; experiments in science; home alone instructions and babysitting (diapering included!); art; and discoveries in pre-history.

Recommended classes for visual appeal are:

morning classes 9 a.m. - 11:30 a.m.

Dinosaurs (L100) - pre-K and K, children imaginary time travel to several prehistoric periods to learn about dinosaurs, fossils, and cave dwellers; **Crafty Kids (PC237)** - grades 1 - 3, children will make bird houses, photo albums, and nature-based crafts; **Science-wise (SC190)**- grades 4 - 7, children will create experiments in physics, chemistry, and other areas; and **Computer Kids (OC2024)** - students will sample a variety of applications software including word processing, graphics spreadsheets and the World Wide Web.

Afternoon classes 12:30 - 3 p.m.

Dabble in the Arts (TC115A) - pre-K and K, focus is on painting, puppetry, collages, and creating structures; **Wonder Science (TC237)** - grades 1 - 3, students will explore life, earth, physical, chemical, and space sciences; **Kids in the Kitchen (L100)** - grades 2 - 4, recipes will enforce math and science skills as children measure, mix, and experiment.

The summer also offers:

Horse Lover's Clinic June 30 and July 1 at Cedarwood Farms - ages 7 - 12, participants will saddle and ride twice daily and learn about grooming, equine anatomy, and safety;

Surfin' the Net for Parents and Kids June 9 and 16 at USI (OC3074) - grades 2 - 6, parents and kids work together to learn about computer basics;

SAT 1 preparations June 13 and 20 at USI (OC2005, OC3074) - grades 9 - 12, students develop strategies for test-taking, identifying study priorities, and working practice questions.
