

1996 USI VOLLEYBALL OUTLOOK

The University of Southern Indiana volleyball team is looking to jump back into the upper division of the Great Lakes Valley Conference in 1996.

The Screaming Eagles return a veteran squad from last season's team which was 14-15 overall, 9-11 in the GLVC. USI missed the GLVC Playoffs and finished seventh.

This year, the Eagles have eight returning players, led by junior outside/middle hitter Jamie Roth (Springfield, Ill.). Roth led the Eagles with 372 kills, a .308 hitting percentage, and 46 aces.

Roth also ranked fourth in the GLVC in hitting percentage and eighth in kills per game and aces per game.

A second junior looking to make a move in 1996 is middle hitter Rebecca Tillema (Wheatfield, Ind.). Tillema was second on the team with 266 kills, but led the team in blocks with 57 solo and 72 assists. She ranked third in the GLVC for total blocks per game with 1.27.

All-time at USI, Roth ranks fourth in kills, while Tillema ranks fifth in blocks solo.

Rounding out the junior class is outside hitter Stephanie Shidler (Plymouth, Ind.). Shidler was fifth for the Eagles with 142 kills.

Perhaps the most consistent player over the last three seasons is senior outside/middle hitter Andrea Miller (Ft. Branch, Ind.). Miller, one of two seniors on the team, was fourth for USI with 171 kills and a .210 hitting percentage. She also tied for third on the squad in blocks.

Miller, who was named to the Academic All-GLVC team for a second straight season in 1995, ranks fifth all-time at USI in blocks.

Also a senior, the Eagles will be able to look for a contribution from outside hitter

Teresa Billings (Newburgh, Ind.). Billings was fifth on the team in aces with 21 off the bench in 1995.

USI has three players entering their second season of play at the collegiate level. Tai Richardson (Cayuga, Ind.), the team's sophomore setter, led USI with 897 assists moving her into third place all-time as an Eagle.

Looking for more action in 1996 is sophomore outside hitter Ann-Marie Hourigan (Mountmellick, Ireland) and Owen Daniels (Hammond, Ind.).

New to the team is freshman middle/outside hitter Danielle Peter (Tell City, Ind.), freshman outside hitter Cara Cox (New Albany, Ind.), and freshman defensive specialist Chantel Taylor (Orleans, Ind.). Peter was named All-Conference all four seasons and squad Most Valuable Player three straight years at Perry Central High School in Leopold, Ind.

The Eagles are directed by fifth-year Head Coach Kelly Boyd. Boyd has led USI to a winning season in three of her four seasons at the helm and became USI's all-time winningest coach for volleyball with a career record of 63-51 (.553).

HEAD COACH KELLY BOYD

Kelly Boyd begins her fifth season as head volleyball coach at the University of Southern Indiana in 1996.

The 1995 season saw the Eagles go 14-15 overall, 9-11 GLVC, in Boyd's fourth season as coach.

In 1994, Boyd completed her third straight winning season with the Eagles. She led the Eagles to a 15-14 overall record and a seventh-place finish in the GLVC.

In 1993, Boyd led the Eagles to a 20-9 record and a 6-3 fifth-place finish in the Great Lakes Valley Conference.

Boyd became the volleyball head coach in 1992, and in that first year led the Eagles to a 14-13 mark and a 5-4 GLVC record, finishing in the upper division. During her first two seasons as volleyball coach, Boyd also was an assistant coach on the women's basketball team.

While a graduate assistant coach for women's basketball at Eastern Kentucky University in Richmond, Kentucky, Boyd earned her master's degree in physical education/sports administration. She is a native of Argeta, Ill., and earned her bachelor's degree in physical education in 1990 from Northeast Missouri State University, where she played varsity basketball from 1987 to 1989.

In addition to her duties as volleyball coach, Boyd teaches in the USI Physical Education Department.

ASSISTANT COACH MICHELLE WELP

Michelle Welp begins her first season as an assistant coach and her fifth at USI as a student.

A four-year letter winner, Welp graduated from USI with a bachelor's in psychology and is pursuing a Master of Social Work at USI. While studying at USI, she was named to the Academic All-GLVC team three straight seasons (1993, 1994, and 1995).

On the volleyball court, Welp was named All-GLVC in 1994 and ranks first all-time in digs while ranking second all-time in kills, hitting percentage, service aces, and block assists. The Jasper, Ind., native also is third all-time in blocks solo.
