STUDENTS FOR ACHIEVEMENT

More than 100 students were honored for academic achievement and service to the University and community Thursday, April 27, in the annual Honors Day Ceremony at the University of Southern Indiana.

The University's top awards were presented to Dr. Darrel E. Bigham, a history professor, and Gloria Gail Moore, a 42-year-old Evansville grandmother who is graduating magna cum laude in her quest for a "major change in my life." Dr. Bigham received the National City Bank Distinguished Professor Award, a faculty recognition for a colleague who has demonstrated dedication to teaching and a quest for excellence. The award is supported by a \$1,000 grant from National City Bank. Mrs. Moore, a firm believer in the Liberal Arts education which has her considering an offer to be a researcher in Time magazine's Tampa, Florida, office, was presented both the President's Medal -- an award established by the faculty to recognize a graduating senior who has excelled academically and has given service to the University and community -- and the 1989 Liberal Arts Award.

The first annual Albert A. Woll Memorial Scholarship -- a \$500 award established by the family of the late Evansville businessman and supporter of education for presentation to a pre-medical student demonstrating financial need -- went to Daniel Schmitt of RR 1, Jasper, Indiana. Schmitt had attended Vincennes University classes to learn printing prior to transferring to USI, where he decided to switch to pre-med. He is an honor student (his GPA is 3.73 out of a possible 4.0) described by a faculty member as a person who makes a cliche a fact -- "he really wants to be of service to mankind."

The 22-year-old Schmitt had dropped out of school for a year to earn tuition, only to discover the money he earned had wiped out his eligibility for financial aid. The Woll scholarship -- a renewable award -- is helping him stay in school.
