Robert W. Swan, regional administrative partner with Kemper CPA Group, has been named to the University of Southern Indiana Board of Trustees by Governor Evan Bayh. The appointment is effective July 1.

Swan will succeed Carole D. Rust as the alumni representative on the Board. He is a 1972 graduate. She is a '77 graduate who had served on the Board since it was created in 1985.

Swan joined Price Waterhouse & Co. in Chicago after graduation, becoming the first USI alumnus to join the Big Eight in accounting firms. He later was assistant controller for the Santa Fe Energy Company in Amarillo, Texas, for five years before joining Kemper in 1981.

Swan was president of the USI Alumni Association in 1988. He is a charter member of the School of Business Board of Visitors and a member of the USI Foundation Board of Directors. He also is president of Southern Indiana Chapter, Indiana CPA Society; board member and treasurer of the Rotary Club; and a board member of United Way of Southwestern Indiana.
