Numeracy - a videoconference on adult math education slated at USI

"Adult Numeracy Instruction: A New Approach" is a free videoconference dealing with math anxiety for both adult literacy learners and teachers that will be aired at 12 noon Thursday, December 1, in the Conference Center at University of Southern Indiana.

The program is sponsored by the National Center on Adult Literacy and PBS Adult Learning Service, and is being coordinated by the USI University Division and Ivy Tech Southwest. Participants are invited to arrive at 11:30 a.m. with a brown bag lunch; beverages will be available.

The videoconference is open to all who are interested but is commended to volunteers and professionals involved with adult education and literacy programs, many of whom find themselves providing limited math instruction for learners without preparation for it. Also considered is the significant reform that has occurred in elementary and secondary math instruction.
